



Who in God's name would deny health care to the poor?


Preacher Dan Hall.

Tim Pawlenty said "God's in charge" after cutting health care to 30,000 of the poorest Minnesotans.¹ Preacher Dan Hall remained silent.

Why won't Preacher Hall side with the poor against politicians?

Leaders of the faith community railed against Pawlenty's decision to demolish the health care system for our poor and elderly, admonishing him by saying "Don't pass this off on God." Preacher Hall remained silent following Pawlenty's cuts, and now endorses Tom Emmer, who stands with Pawlenty in rejecting over \$1 billion in federal aid that would extend Minnesota's health care for the poor — choosing partisan politics instead of standing up for those who most need help.3
